

Conference Terms and Conditions of the 20th Conference of Science and Business People

§ 1 - Organizers and partner of the 20th Conference

1. The organizer of the 20th Conference is the Foundation for the Dissemination of Knowledge and Science "Cognitione" (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer") and the Institute of Economics, Polish Academy of Sciences (INE-PAN)
2. The organizer assures that he will make every effort to ensure that the Conference takes place as described.

§ 2 Rules for participation

1. Participation in the Conference for all Participants and Authors / Co-authors is payable. Each Participant and Authors / Co-authors are required to pay a conference fee of PLN 1070.00 to the bank account provided on the website <http://konferencja.jemi.edu.pl/en/conditions-of-participation> along with the title of the transfer "Conference 2021 plus first and last name of participant".
2. The Conference fee applies to each Author / Co-author individually and each article individually, even if the articles published by the same Author are more than one. In this case, for each additional article Autor / Co-author bears an additional fee. The absence does not reduce the fee, which is fixed and does not change regardless of participation in the Conference.
3. The author can submit a maximum of 2 articles.
4. The Conference fee of 1070,00 PLN includes the conference organization costs, costs of the publishing process, the costs of the process of indexing the monograph, and catering during the traditionally held venue.
5. The Conference fee does not include travel and accommodation costs. Booking of accommodation (s) should be made independently.
6. Registration for the Conference is done by completing the on-line application form, which can be found at Author Zone <http://konferencja.jemi.edu.pl/en/>. During registration, it is mandatory to provide all the data required on the registration form.

7. The registration will be carried out until the day specified in the Condition of Participation contained on the Conference website.
8. The condition for participation in the Conference is the registration referred to in § 2 pct. 6, making the payment in the amount of 1070.00 in the prescribed period and sending the Declaration for Authors located on the website of the Conference.
9. The Conference participant may be a research worker, a Ph.D. student and acting practitioners for the transfer of knowledge within the framework of cooperation between science and business.
10. The Conference is divided into sessions run by Moderators selected by the Organizer.
11. The Organizer reserves the right to extend the registration or earlier ending in case of using all available places intended for Conference Participants.
12. The Organizer will post information about possible changes to the dates on the website: <http://konferencja.jemi.edu.pl/en/> .
13. The Organizer reserves the right to send e-mails to the Participants until the end of the publication process and launch a new edition of the Conference.
14. Sending the Application Form is equivalent to the acceptance of the Conditions of Participation and the Terms available at <http://konferencja.jemi.edu.pl/en/conditions-of-participation>

§ 3 - Resignation from participation in the Conference

1. The participant of the Conference who has registered has the right to resign altogether of the Conference without cause and is required to inform the Conference Organizer in advance however no later than 8 weeks before the beginning of the Conference. This information should be sent to the email address: fundacja@cognitione.org .
2. In the event of cancellation of participation at a later date, the Organizer shall not reimburse the costs incurred by the Participant.

§ 4 - Cancellation of the Conference

1. The Conference Organizer reserves the right to change the Conference program or its cancellation for reasons completely independent of the Organizer. In each of the above, the Organizer will inform the Participants about this fact to the e-mail addresses indicated by them in the Application Form.
2. To the fullest extent permitted by Polish law, the Organizer excludes its liability for damage suffered by the Participants in connection with the organization, the course,

cancellation or postponement of the Conference. The organizer does not bear liability for damages and benefits lost by the Participants in this respect.

§ 5 - Benefits

1. The Organizer of the Conference is obliged to provide Benefits to Participants in the form of catering, publication of post-conference monographs in print or electronic form.
2. The Organizer undertakes to issue the Certificate of Participation in the Conference.
3. The result of the Conference will be the scientific monograph (hereinafter referred to as "Conference Proceedings") consisting of an article submitted by the Participants.
4. Each article will be sent to a double-blind review, which will be made in accordance with the criteria contained in the Review Form located on the website: <http://konferencja.jemi.edu.pl/en/conditions-of-participation>
5. Participant's articles may appear in the Conference Proceedings only after positive reviews.
6. In the case of a negative review, the Participant is obliged to correct the article in accordance with the comments of the Reviewers.
7. The Reviewers may not accept the article for publication if the Participant has not done due diligence in improving the article .
8. The article may be rejected if the Author / Co-authors have not adopted the text to the formal requirements of the Conference Proceedings (the layout of the content for the separated sections, text editing, drawings, tables and quotes according to the APA Style format). The formal requirements referred to is available on the Conference Terms of Participation (see: Paper template, Review forms, Reference style). In such a situation, the Participant is not entitled to reimbursement of the conference fee incurred.

§ 6 - Final provisions

1. The Organizer of the Conference is not responsible for the items of Participants that may be lost, damaged or stolen during the Conference.
2. Participants bear full financial responsibility for their destruction on the premises where the Conference takes place.
3. Sending the application to participate in the Conference is tantamount to consent to the collection of and processing of personal data (within the scope given to the Organizer) for organizational, recruitment, promotional and marketing purposes by the Organizer. The participant agrees to receive such content from these organizations in accordance with the Act of August 29, 1997 on the Protection of Personal Data (original text, OJ 1997 No. 133, item 883, as amended, consolidated text Dz. U. 2002 No. 101, item 926 - hereinafter the Act).

4. The participant undertakes to apply to the requirements of these Regulations as well adhere to the security rules and the instructions and organizational and technical instructions of the Organizer's representative during the Conference. The organizer does not ensure the Conference Participants and does not bear any responsibility for events resulting from non-compliance with the terms of participation.
5. The Organizer has the right to exclude a participant from the Conference without giving a reason in case the participant's actions negatively affect the good name or otherwise cause or may cause harm to the Organizer, Co-Organizers, Partners and Conference Participants.
6. The organizer agrees to a professional recording of sound and / or image during Conference. The participant declares that he/she agrees that photos and / or videos that contain your image can be registered during the implementation of the Conference social media (e.g., Facebook), on the website, Internet, reports to the Ministry, messages promoting the event. At the same time, the Organizer acknowledges that the image of the Participant will be used only for the purposes of promotion and the needs of the Conference.
7. The personal data administrator is the Organizer. The Organizer undertakes to fully respect the rights of Participants under the provisions of the Personal Data Protection Act (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2002, No. 101, item 926, as amended). Therefore the Participant has the right to access your data at any time, modify it or request complete deletion.
8. Registering as a Participant of the Conference is tantamount to accepting the provisions of these Regulations, as well as compliance with the order and any other arrangements made between the Participant and the Organizer of the Conference.
9. The Organizer reserves the right to change these Terms and Conditions in subsequent editions. The interpretation of the Terms and Conditions and the resolution of disputable issues and problems not included in these Terms and Conditions shall be granted only to the Organizer.
